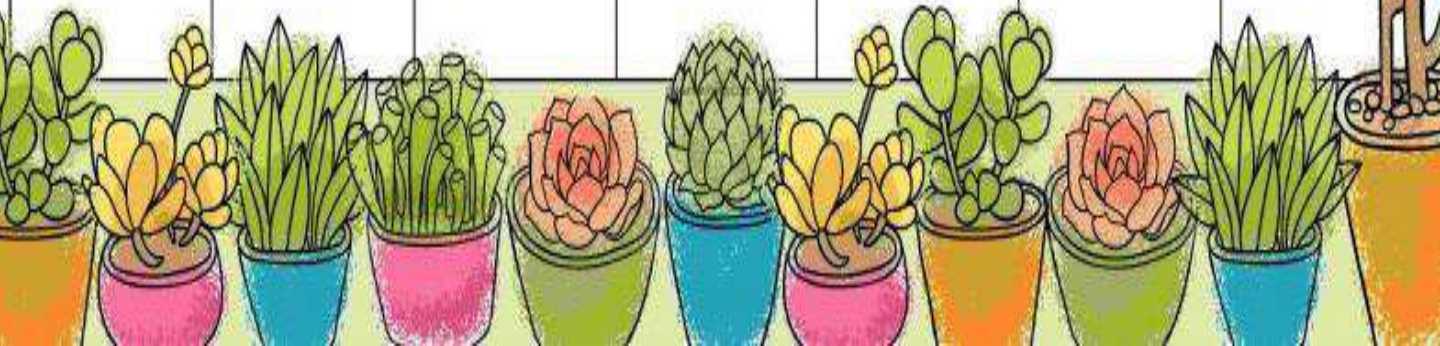

DRESS CODE

All players and visitors are expected to be dressed appropriately on the Club's premises. **Neat and tidy** is the basic code subject to the following:

GOLF COURSE

Men

Golf shirts with sleeves and collar/Mock turtleneck
Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
Shorts must have an inseam of at least 8" inches.

Ladies

Tailored Golf shirts with sleeves and collar/mock turtleneck
Sleeveless shirts permitted only if with collar
Tailored shorts, slacks or skirts.

Shorts must have an inseam of at least 6" inches or be no shorter than 5" above the knee. Skirts must also be no shorter than 5" above the knee

All golfers are required to wear golf shoes with soft spikes

NOT PERMITTED ON GOLF COURSE

Tank tops, T-shirts
Cut off, bleached shorts, Gym shorts or running pants,
Blue denim Jeans or jeans with holes, ragged hems
Cargo pants, ¾ jeans
Low rider jeans, bare mid-riffs, cut outs
Slippers or sandals of any kind including push toe/flip flops.

CLUB HOUSE

Conservative and modest wear is required. Slippers or Sandals are permitted.

NOT PERMITTED

Hats
Swimwear or bareback
Sleeveless shirts or cutouts, cut-off pants
Flip flops and Tee Shirts

Spectators must also be dressed appropriately.
Short shorts, bare mid-riffs, appropriate footwear

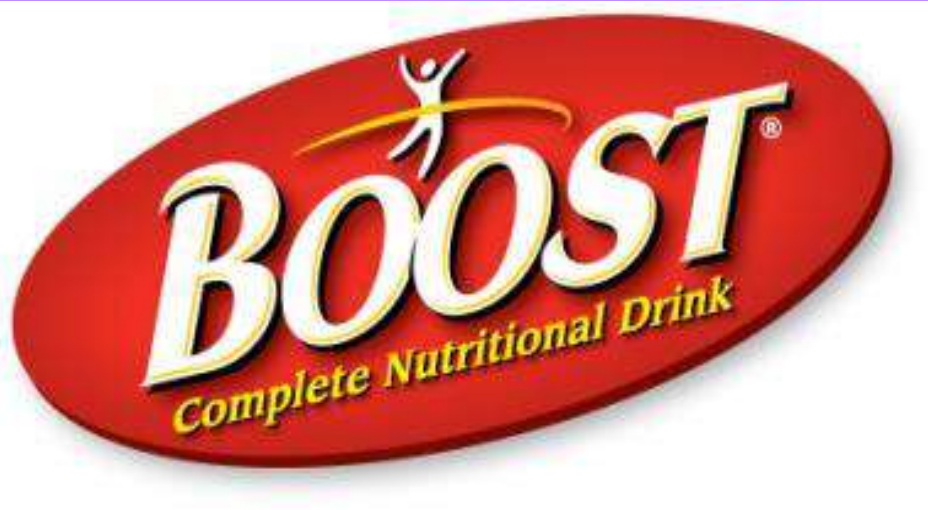
It is each member's responsibility to advise their guests of the dress code of the club prior to their guest's arrival at the club.
